## **PROJECTS**

### **Kapow, Sobold Ltd — Wordpress to NextJS conversion**

**The Scenario:** Kapow being Sobolds' largest client, requested that we shift the current implementation over to a more sustainable and faster framework.

**The Issue:** The current implementation was built on Wordpress with a huge array of plugins including Memberpress, which impeded the site to the point where multiple issues were reported and users would stop using the application all together, they required a more efficient and faster solution.

**The Solution:** Rebuild the entire site using NextJS and leverage the Rest API from Wordpress to create a headless build.

### **Hornby Hobbies, Rawnet — Ongoing retainership work**

Hornbie was one of Rawnets largest clients, Hornby was the umbrella company for multiple other companies. I was tasked to do multiple UI development tasks for Hornby and the other umbrella companies that came with it.

### **Lenovo, Twogether — Ongoing retainership work**

At Twogether, I built and deployed numerous landing pages for Lenovo—one of our largest clients—using GIT pipelines. I regularly integrated new technologies, enhancing my development skills with tools like jQuery, Angular (1 & 2+), Node.js, and Gulp.
